Fact Finding Committee Report

Name of the College: C.P. College of Education, Jalna

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- 1. Affiliation:** - C.P. College of Education, Jalna offers an undergraduate (B.Ed.) program with a capacity for 100 students, established in 2005, and a postgraduate (M.Ed.) program with a capacity for 50 students, established in 2009. However, it is noted, in accordance with NCTE norms, that the college currently does not meet the criteria for appointing qualified academic faculty and administrative staff, providing necessary facilities, instructional resources, and other amenities. Additionally, the affiliation process for the academic year 2021-2022 has not yet been completed.
 - 2 Regular Principal:-** The institution conducted interviews on October 7, 2023, and subsequently appointed Dr. Jain Gajanan Vithoba as the Principal of C. P. College of Education, Jalna, effective from September 11, 2023. The appointment of the Principal is pending towards University.
 - 3. University Approved Teaching Faculty:-**

For the UG (B.Ed.) course with a capacity of 100 students, the NCTE mandates a professional staff, including 1 Principal, 4 Perspectives in Education instructors, qualified academic faculty, qualified administrative staff, 8 Pedagogy Subject educators, 1 Health & Physical Education instructor, 1 Fine Arts instructor, and 1 Performing Arts instructor.

Currently, the college has appointed Principal but has no University approval, and for Perspectives in Education and Pedagogy Subjects, there are only 4 approved faculty members. Despite this, since 2016, the university has not granted approval, except for the 4 faculty members who have received it.

The PG (M.Ed.) course has a capacity of 50 students, divided into first and second years with 100 students in total. As per NCTE and PAR standards, the required faculty comprises 2 professors, 2 associate professors, 6 assistant professors, and administrative staff including 1 librarian, 1 librarian assistant/resource center coordinator, 2 office assistants, and 1 helper. Unfortunately, the concerned college has not appointed the necessary faculty as per these guidelines.

The University has not yet received the undertaking of working of the institution and not working elsewhere from the current staff .

4. Administrative Supporting Staff:- Non-teaching staff has not been appointed.

5. Laboratory Staff:- As per the NCTE norms laboratory Staff is not appointed. Laboratories :- In the current academic year, the college acquired psychological tests and computers. Although the Science Laboratory and Psychology Laboratory are partially fulfilled, well-equipped and furnished laboratories for both undergraduate and postgraduate courses, including Science Lab, Language Lab, ICT Lab, Curriculum Resource Lab, etc., are essential, but nothing is found accordingly in the institution in this visit also

6. Class Room:- Presently the following classrooms exist in the college

- B.Ed. Hall :01(Area 25x21)
- B.Ed. Classroom: total 02 (Area 21x23)(44x21)
- M.Ed. Classroom :02 (Area 21x23)(20x30)
- Method Hall : total 03(Area 21x23),(21x14.5)(23x21)
- Auditorium :01(40x21.5)

These all classrooms are **not well equipped** and furnished with all amenities mentioned in NCTE Norms. Digital Classroom not available.

7. Student Amenities:- Presently the following student amenities exist in the college – Boy's Room (20x30), Girl's Room with no facilities. There is separate Ground and very few sport equipment's found in very bad condition. Parking facility without shed, Drinking Water Facility, separate boy's toilet and girl's toilet, No ramp facility for (physically challenged students).

8. Library:- The college purchased new books for the current academic year, possessing a library hall stocked with curriculum-focused reference materials. However, the M.Ed. program lacks research journals, an e-library setup, Wi-Fi, internet facilities, and library software. To meet the needs of both faculty and students, an adequately equipped and furnished library with ICT resources and a reading room is not available. It was observed that very few transaction of books in library takes place

9. Observations:

- a) Biometric report for September 2023 only was shown to the committee.
- b) Science books were purchased in July 2023.
- c) Equipment of science lab were added in July 2023.
- d) Annual subscriptions for journals (total quantity 5) were added in December 2023.
- e) University approvals for Principal and teaching faculty are required.
- f) Infrastructural facilities need to be increased.
- g) Well-equipped and furnished smart classrooms are required.
- h) Library and library amenities facilities should be updated.
- i) Basic facilities such as classroom boards, fans, lights, etc., are lacking in some classrooms.
- j) Laboratories are not well-furnished and equipped.
- k) Research cubicles are not available.

- l) Service books of Staff are not maintained.
- m) ICT lab should updated with purchase of new computer
- n) Sport equipment, art and craft resources, psychological equipment and tests, new desks, language lab software and computers, office facilities, and all classroom facilities need to be Purchased according to the intake capacity of students and NCTE norms
- o) University approved teachers are only 4 in no.
- p) For seeking NOC certificate from university institution faculty has shown 09 faculty bout of which only 3 where present before the committee
- q) From University they have shown total 09 faculty out of which only 03 where present before the committee
- r) No bank passbook of Teaching faculties maintained in the office
- s) Non-Teaching staff is not appointed
- t) Undertaking demanded by University regarding not doing services elsewhere is not submitted yet by the faculty nor administration
- u) It was observed that the presently shown principal was not known with his surname by any other faculty member
- v) Salary given to faculty members is from 15,000/- to 25000/-
- w) Not a single faculty was able to tell about which semester of B.Ed is going on at the time of committee visit.
- x) Only One faculty is appointed for M.Ed.(Post graduate course) for the strength of 50 student
- y) Biometric attendance of teaching and non-teaching faculty shown to the committee is not maintain in the institution
- z) The audit report shown to the committee doesn't match of the record of staff salaries. is available but does not match staff
