AURANGABAD.****The Resolution of Law Courses decided by the BoS in Law its meeting
held on 21st December, 2021.**

<u>R. No.</u>	<u>Resolution's</u>
01.	The old students who are already admitted in the Academic year 2021-2022 in various affiliated colleges are recommended to be continued in the said course subject to the equivalence from the Eligibility section of the University. Further it is also unanimously resolved to allow such students of old syllabus in the Academic year 2022-2023, 2023-2024 as a last chance as per the BCI/UGC COVID-19 protocol. <u>Strictly informed to all the affiliated colleges not to admit old syllabus students after 2023-2024 Academic year.</u> The Students who are admitted from the old syllabus with equivalence provided full carry-on due to three Academic years (2021-2024) restrictions, as a last chance.
02.	To promote those students with ATKT and who paid the examination fees to the next Academic year due to the Bar Council Restriction of completion of the course within 6/8 years for the LL.B. 3 years / B.A. LL.B. 5 Years Law Courses respectively.
03.	The exemption for UG/PG Law Courses in the Subject of Constitution Law and Environmental Law as law Students have 100 Marks papers for each of these subjects as compulsory course.
04.	To implement MOOC Course for the benefit of students as optional for the skill development from second year of three years law course and fourth year of five years law course.
