(Note :- Registration as a post graduate student shall be a condition precedent to the commencement of studies for the degree of M.F.A. by research)

A candidate for being eligible for admission to the Master of fine Arts degree course by research in the branches of 01 Illustration 02 Visualization 03 Typography 04 Photography B.F.A (Applied Art) Degree form this or any University or Government Diploma in Art (Applied Art) of the Government of Maharashtra state or an equivalent thereto passed and must have thereafter obtained five years experience of Professional (Applied Art) / teaching to the classes leading to the B.F.A. Degree (Applied Art) in any University or the Government diploma of art (Applied Art) of government of Maharashtra state & equivalent

five years of Professional experience in Applied Art discipline are Outstanding in relevant field on state, National / International level achievement (Ad -agency Experience, awards, workshops, demonstrations. etc)

a) In all the specialization prescribed for the M.F.A. degree by Research only five candidate in each specialization are allowed to enroll in every academic year / 20 candidates in each discipline (Painting & Applied Art)

b) A candidate seeking admission to the M.F.A. degree courses by Research shall have to registered as a post graduate student under a teacher recognized by the University and submit through him a synopsis of the topic of his Dissertation which should be related to the branches prescribed for the M.F.A. degree by Research

c) The M.F.A. degree courses by Research shall consist of a dissertation and a projects work (practical) .

d) The nature of the project work(practical) and the dissertation to be submitted by the candidate for the M.F.A. degree courses by Research in the branches if Illustration / Visualization / Typography, Photography shall be as under.

M.F.A. by Research (Project work practical)

a) Any one of the following subjects: - Illustration / Visualization / Typography, Photography any one for the following process

Quantum of work to be submitted in Four Semester (two years) :-

Illustration :- Minimum 20 assignments (05 Each sem.) & 20 color hand work Related to assignment (05 Each sem. / half Impairer paper) should be submitted .

Visualization :- Minimum 20 assignments (05 Each sem.) & 20 color hand work Related to assignment (05 Each sem. / half Impairer paper) should be submitted .

Photography - Minimum 20 assignments (05 Each sem.) & rough scribble (but finish) Related to assignment / specialization. (05 Each sem. / half Impairer paper) should be submitted.

Typography - Minimum 20 assignments (05 Each sem.) & create own one type within four sem. (05 Each sem. / half Impairer paper) should be submitted.

b) Nature of Dissertation:- Comprehensively Illustrated with a minimum 10000 to 15000 words

c) Guide teacher may be external or internal he must have university recognized teacher with minimum 10 year teaching experience from Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University or any University from Maharashtra.

D) Two month before submitting the Dissertation the candidate shall forward do the Registrar, through his guiding teacher who is recognized by the University. For the purpose a statement giving the title and synopsis of the Dissertation along with the prescribed fees.

e) The referees shall make their report after evaluating Dissertation and the project work (practical) and holding a viva-voce Examination of the candidate to test his knowledge of the subject. The referees shall report to the competent Authority the result of the evaluation of the Dissertation and / or project work practical and their report shall be final.

The external referees shall be persons residing in India, who are expert in the subject. The Viva- voce shall be held jointly by the external referees and the guiding Teacher, only after the Dissertation and the project work

(practical) have been valued by both the external referees, and the time of holding it the referees conducting , the viva – voce shall have the Dissertation in their hands and the project work displayed at the same.

f) The examiner will indicate whether the Dissertation and the project work (practical) have been accepted or rejected, if accept then panel will decide the merit of the candidate to following marking system / ten point grades.

g) A Dissertation that has been rejected may be submitted again after due revision for not more than one attempts with admission - Extension (as per Examiners remark)
