

Instructions to the Students opting Pre PhD coursework through Swayam

- Student is advised to gain 12 credits inclusive of Paper-1 (Research Methodology) and Paper-2 (Thrust Area / Subject Domain) for fulfilment of Pre Ph.D. coursework 2022 through Swayam framework.
- Two credits for the seminar will be in consultation with research guide.
- Credits related to Hands on instrumentation Section need to be gained through the visits to different laboratories of reputed national research institutes / university departments / research centers / library of university etc. These said visits are monitored by research guide / supervisors. It is necessary to maintain necessary documentation of all said visits and report of each visit is required to be prepared by the scholar and endorsed by the guide. Minimum four visits are required to be completed by the scholar and after completion of all visits, report of each visit endorsed by the guide will be submitted to research Centre.

Process for coursework through Swayam

- Courses delivered through SWAYAM are available free of cost for course enrolment to the scholars.
- The **examination fee** for each course is Rs. 1000/- for general applicants and Rs. 500/- for SC / ST / OBC / PwD candidates with more than 40% disability.
- The university has earmarked SWAYAM courses and the list of these courses are available in / on university website / in the accounts research scholar's Online Ph.D. Portal. The scholars are advised to refer the courses for:
 - a) **Research Methodology (Paper 1) (6 Credits Mandatory)**
 - b) **Thrust Area/Subject Domain (Paper 2) (6 Credits Mandatory)**
- **SWAYAM Enrolment process**
 - It is necessary for the Scholars to register themselves on SWAYAM portal through www.swayam.gov.in for creating their account on to the SWAYAM platform.
 - After having account on SWAYAM, the scholar is advised to click on / copy the link of the earmarked courses suggested by the university in your web browser.

- After getting the earmarked course in your browser, the respective course information will be displayed on the screen. The scholar needs to click on **Join the course** link / button to join the course.
- Please note that, all Alerts and detailed information about the course will be updated on your registered email address (the email address you used for creation of account at SWAYAM portal). Keep your inbox accessed frequently so that you will not miss out any important communication.
- Scholar needs to follow the guidelines Time to Time provided in email.
- **SWAYAM Examination**
 - SWAYAM is offering all self-paced courses, therefore students are advised to see all options offered to the students.
 - After successful completion of the course students will undergo Swayam examination by paying required fees as applicable to the scholar.
 - SWAYAM examinations are proctored and conducted on the designated centers, the scholars are advised to attend the examination on designated center.
- After successful completion of the SWAYAM examination students will submit completion score card cum certificate to research center as well as HRDC, Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University.
- After receiving the certificates for 12 credits gained by students from SWAYAM, required mandatory credits from research guide towards evaluation of Seminar, and completion of Hands-on Instrumentation, HRDC will release Certificate for completion of Pre Ph.D. Coursework 2022.
