Instruction for Ph.D. Entrance Test, PET 2021

- 1. The Ph.D. Entrance Test (PET) shall be conducted in two phases i.e. PET-I and PET-II.
- 2. PET-I shall be online and of a duration of 90 minutes with maximum 100 marks.
- 3. PET-I shall have 100 multiple choice questions from different areas as mentioned below:
 - i. Analytical Reasoning
 - ii. Numerical Ability
 - iii. Language Competency
 - iv. Computer and Environment Awareness
 - v. Logical Reasoning and Data Interpretation
- 4. The Assessment of PET I shall have negative marking i.e. the student shall get 1 mark for each correct answer while for each wrong answer, 0.5 mark shall be deducted.
- 5. A students has to score maximum 50 marks (in case of open category students) and 45 marks (in case of backward class category students) to qualify the examination.
- 6. The students those who qualify PET-I are eligible for PET-II
- 7. PET-II shall be online and subject specific including Research methodology.
- 8. PET-II shall be of a duration of 90 minutes with maximum 100 marks.
- 9. A student has to score minimum 40% marks in each section and 50% marks in total to qualify the examination. However, the

backward category student shall get 5% relaxation to qualify the examination.

- 10. Syllabus for PET-II is available on the website of the University https://online.bamu.ac.in/unic/phd/.
- 11. The PET 2021 score will valid for 1 year only.
- 12. Successful in PET examination or merely submission of application for Ph.D. registration shall not confer on the candidate right of Admission to PhD programme.
- 13. Admission to PhD Programme shall be on availability of vacant seats at Research Centres & availability of vacant seats with University recognised PhD Supervisor as per decision of RRC.
- 14. Fees: (to be paid online)
 - i. PET Fees: Rs.1000. for (For Open category students) Rs.600 for (For Backward class category students).
 - ii. Registration Fees: Rs. 300 for (For Open category students) Rs.200 for (For Backward class category Students)
- 15. The syllabus of PET, other instructions of admission process will be displayed on the website of University https://online.bamu.ac.in/unic/phd/ time to time.
- 17. If any changes in the schedule of PET then it will be notify on the website of University.
