	(ii) A minimum of Ten years of teaching experience in university/college as Assistant Professor / Associate Professor / Professor, and / or research experience at equivalent level at the University / National / International Level Institutions with evidence of having successfully guided doctoral candidate.

(B)	An outstanding professional, having a Ph.D. degree in the relevant / allied / applied disciplines, from any National / International academic institutions, (not included in 'A' above) / industry who has made significant contribution to the knowledge in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline, supported by documentary evidence provided he / she has ten years experience

(1)	A Master's degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) in a concerned / relevant / allied subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university by vide UGC circular.
	AND
(2)	National Eligibility Test (NET), State Eligibility Test (SET) and State Level Eligibility Test (SLET) will be the minimum criteria for the direct recruitment to the post of Assistant Professor for all higher education institutions.
	Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree (in concerned/relevant subject) in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time, as the case may be exempted from NET/SET. NET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SET is not conducted. However, Ph.D. degree shall remain the minimum eligibility for appointment of Assistant Professor in such disciplines.
